POLICY STATEMENT

Degree-seeking students who have not enrolled in any course at the University for three (3) consecutive semesters must apply for readmission (excluding military withdraws) and as a result have been discontinued from the university. Students who withdrew in good standing during a previous term or who have been out of school for fewer than three consecutive terms are eligible to return without filing an application for readmission.

SCOPE

This applies to all degree-seeking undergraduate students who were previously enrolled at FIU as a degree-seeking student but did not complete a degree. Have not completed a bachelor’s degree elsewhere since leaving FIU. Have not enrolled in any coursework at FIU for at least three (3) or more consecutive terms and as a result have been discontinued from the university.

Returning after academic dismissal
 FIU has the following policies for students who left FIU with a GPA below 2.0 or were academically dismissed from the university.
 All former FIU students requesting academic Salvage/Amnesty must first reapply for admission via the online admission application. Applicants must select academic amnesty policy or academic salvage policy at time of application for readmission.

REASON FOR POLICY

A returning student is admitted pursuant to this policy to ensure access to prior coursework and degree completion without intentionally adding excess credit hours for courses previously completed.

DEFINITIONS	
TERM	DEFINITIONS
Academic Dismissal	A student who left FIU with less than a 2.0 GPA



Academic Amnesty	A process in which a student who left with a GPA below a 2.0 or dismissed from FIU, has not enrolled in any university or college for at least six (6) calendar years. Restarts at FIU with a 0.0 GPA but may receive credit toward degree for prior courses completed with a C or better
Academic Salvage	A process in which a student who left with a GPA below a 2.0 or dismissed from FIU, has earned an Associate of Arts degree (AA) from another Florida public institution. Readmitted student will begin with 60 hours and an FIU GPA of 0.0.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Admissions Operations processes the application and transcripts. The academic department dean or designee may provide a recommendation for admission to a specific major or program due to specialized admissions or pre-requisite courses required to continue as an upper-division student. Director of University Admissions or designee provides oversight for policy alignment to Florida BOG regulations for admission.
