POLICY STATEMENT

The University Core Curriculum includes 36 hours of general education course work selected from the following five subject-matter categories: Communication; Humanities; Mathematics; Natural Science; and Social Science.

Any student entering Florida International University (FIU) as a first-time college student or transferring in without an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from a Florida public institution is required to fulfill the University Core Curriculum requirements.

SCOPE

This policy applies to undergraduate students and those providing undergraduate academic advisement.
