POLICY STATEMENT

The Faculty Senate Undergraduate Council and the Deans Advisory Council participate in formulating and recommending policy, reviewing procedures, recommending and assessing planning priorities, establishing criteria for maintaining quality and assessing needs. With counsel from these two bodies, undergraduate programs are administered at three distinct levels: the department/program faculty, the college or school, and the Office of the Provost.

SCOPE

This policy applies to undergraduate programs.

REASON FOR POLICY

To establish the division of responsibilities in the administration of undergraduate academic programs.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Deans of each respective unit will assure the maintenance of existing undergraduate programs and the development of appropriate new undergraduate programs in their individual units.
