### POLICY STATEMENT

DEAN'S LIST

An undergraduate degree-seeking student who earns an FIU term/semester GPA of 3.500 or higher on the basis of completing nine or more credit hours during any semester will be placed on the Dean's List for that semester.

#### ACADEMIC HONORS

To graduate with the honors designations listed below, an undergraduate student must receive grade points in a minimum of 40 semester hours of credit at FIU. Credits earned prior to readmission under academic amnesty or salvage are not applicable in computing the FIU 40-credit-requirement grade points to graduate with honors.

Summa Cum Laude Cumulative GPA of 3.900 and higher.

Magna Cum Laude Cumulative GPA of 3.700 to 3.899.

Cum Laude Cumulative GPA of 3.500 to 3.699.

# SCOPE

This policy applies to the University Community including faculty and students as it relates to Dean's List and Academic Honors designation for graduation.

### **REASON FOR POLICY**

To specify baccalaureate-level Dean's List and Academic Honors for graduation criteria requirements.





### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**
